SO WHAT? Demystifying Psychoeducational Assessment Reports

While a psychological assessment is a critical component of diagnosis, far too often, the jargon and statistics that fill the pages of the resulting report appear to have little or no relevance to those who live with or teach children with learning disabilities. Without an understand of how the results can be translated into useful suggestions for ways to help parents, teachers, and the individuals themselves, valuable information may be lost, and the potential benefits bypassed.
